

CRWGA General Membership Meeting – March 3, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 am by Nancy Gerlach with 38 members in attendance. Members were asked if there were any corrections to the February 3, 2026, CRWGA General Meeting minutes. Mary Hayes stated that Team Play on February 12, 2026, was at Seville and not Las Sendas. Motion was made to approve the minutes as corrected. Motion approved and carried.

Treasurer's Report: Molly Heisler reported that the CRWGA's financial position is the same as last year's at this time even though our membership number is lower. Pay-outs remain the same. She will post an updated financial statement in the Club Room when all bills for the Invitational have been paid.

Tournament/ League Play: Jan Biddle reminded members to sign up for the upcoming two-day Club Championship. The game for today's game will require two score cards.

Handicap – Diane Coole stated that currently six members were soft capped and one was hard capped. Nancy Will shot an ES (exceptional score) and dropped her handicap by 3. No PC adjustments were made in February. She then reported that she completed a mandatory yearly review of member handicaps. The USGA handicap system review mechanism flagged six CRWGA members and provided a recommendation for HC adjustment. Diane examined individual circumstances and determined no adjustments were necessary at this time. Another data-system review will be conducted next February. Diane will sign a form to submit to USGA to validate CRWGA members' handicaps.

Social: Marlene Zaharrichuk stated that there will be a social following both days of the Club Championship. She and Judy Dunitz will continue to be responsible for this role next year.

Committee Reports

Central Arizona Golf District - Nancy Gerlach reported for Nancy Will that \$66 was given out for the Blind Draw winners in January. 33 members were eligible in February, and winners will be announced March 10. Names will be posted in the Club Room.

Team Play– Mary Hayes and Sara Levenstein announced that Team Play has two more play days, Cottonwood and Oakwood on April 2nd and 8th. They will attend the Team Play general meeting on the last day. In the current standings, CRWGA is first overall, first in gross score, and third in net score. 23 members have participated in Team Play this year and they encourage more members to sign up next year as the courses and pricing are excellent and the hospitality exceptional.
